# Sheriff's Office Implements Summer Home Protection Plan

As summer gets into full swing the Delaware County Sheriff's Office wants to prevent crime in your neighborhood. Starting Wednesday June 15, you will begin seeing extra patrol in your neighborhood. The Sheriff's Office is implementing its Summer Home Protection Plan.

This plan is a proactive approach to law enforcement. The deputies will be assigned to patrol specific subdivisions for an hour at a time to allow for more visibility to both the community and potential criminals. During this time the Sheriff's Office will begin to take a community policing approach and get involved with the communities that we serve. Deputies will be interacting with the residents and children while remaining observant for any possible criminal activity in the area.

Take the time to say hello to the deputies patrolling your area. You will see deputies patrolling in cars, on motorcycles and on foot. These deputies will be looking for suspicious activity, warning homeowners of the dangers of leaving garage doors open and checking the area for suspicious activity.

## Helpful Home Safety Tips:

- Light up your yard and driveway by turning on outside lights
- Use timers for interior and exterior lights
- Lock the doors to your home
- Lock car doors, remove valuables from your car and put garage doors down
- Lock the mud-room door to the house from the garage
