Call to Order and Roll Call

The Radnor Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, July 14, 2025 at 6:00 PM at the Radnor Township Community Center, 4061 State Route 203, Radnor, Ohio. Chairperson Boysel called the meeting to order and the roll was called; attending were Trustees Dan Boysel, Dave Weber, and Cameron James.

Approval of Minutes

Public Input

- Calvin Milligan presented the Board with a Probate Court Order for the disinterment of Infant Son Milligan. The Board discussed with Mr. Milligan the next steps; the Board emphasized Mr. Milligan is responsible for hiring a licensed and bonded third party contractor and will follow all laws and guidelines. Additionally, the Board plans to discuss the disinterment with the Township's insurance coverage.
- Donna Meyer, township resident and park committee member, introduced the idea for Radnor to hold a Farmer's Market at the township park where a vendor charge could be collected for park improvements.

Fire Department

- Engine 432 has been sent for repairs; Scioto Township Fire Department has loaned us the use of their engine.
- The Board was given a quote to purchase rescue tools for \$15,750.00; Trustee Boysel motioned and Trustee Weber seconded to approve the purchase and wire transfer for the equipment.

Road/Maintenance Department

- Doug Riedel, Delaware County Engineer's Office, notified the Board the road improvements are behind schedule; therefore, OPWC is behind schedule and slated to begin in late August/early September.
- The Board set a Road Tour for August 25, 2025 immediately following their regular monthly meeting at 8:00 AM.
- Mr. James discussed a culvert issue on N. Sectionline Rd. with Mr. Riedel; it is a county issue and Mr. Riedel will look into the issue.
- Todd Coonfare provided the Board with an update on road maintenance and ditch mowing.

Board Report

- Mr. James discussed the park bid invitation; he stated is needs to be advertised by Thursday, July 17, 2025 on the township's website. Joe Clase from Plan 4 Land will provide the bid packet. Mr. James moved and Mr. Boysel seconded to move forward with the bidding process. Vote: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. Motion passed.
- Mr. Weber provided the Board with an estimate for Evans-Steed Road for \$11,865.00 for road repairs. Mr. James moved and Mr. Boysel seconded to approve the estimate. Vote: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. Motion passed.

The Board was presented with Resolution #08-25, A Resolution of Necessity to Levy a Renewal Tax for the Purpose of Roads and Bridges. Mr. Boysel moved and Mr. Weber seconded to approve Resolution #08-25. Vote: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. Motion passed.

Financials/Fiscal Officer

Mr. Weber moved and Mr. Boysel seconded to approve pending warrants detailed in payment listing detail report for July 1, 2025 through July 14, 2025, with exception to check #17527 to Frontier (whose services should all be cancelled). Vote: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. Motion passed.

Trustee James moved and Trustee Weber seconded to enter Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the hiring, firing, compensation, etc. of township personnel. The Board entered executive session at 7:34 PM. Roll call was taken as follows: Boysel, aye; Weber, aye; James, aye. The Board resumed regular open meeting at 8:11 PM. No further action was taken.
