Call to Order and Roll Call

Operations – Cemetery, Roads, Etc.

- Concession stand at ball fields is up and running, water hooked up
- Able sanitation came Thursday and did Community Center/Fire Station and maintenance building. Fire station should be checked every 3 years and maintenance every 4 years
- Mikes Roofing at museum today 4/27/2026 for estimate
- Met with Tony Fisher regarding trees on River Rd \$2800 quote
- Insurance from March 13 storm – possible reimbursement for tree cleanup
- Working on quote for cemetery stone replacement from place in Galion
- Continue clean-up for trees from March 13 storm

- As of 4/27/2026 sold \$27,000 worth of cemetery plots, mostly out of town residents
- Will find out about getting salt at \$62 a ton before cutoff date

Park Report

- Most of the work has been completed
- Flag pole needs to be painted, breakage on base of pole needs repaired
- ODNR has not received info for grant, possibly held up at recorder's office. Paid \$40,000 towards project, waiting for reimbursement. Invoice for \$77,639 received. Need executed recorded grant agreement. Payment is being held up.
- Status of steel from dugout roof - needs removed
- Selling bleachers – needs account info from Todd for gov.com
- Put banners up on ball field fence, would like to purchase 2 additional banners cost \$250. Motion made by Meyer for township to pay. Second by James. Motion granted
- Motion to pay invoice from Plan 4 Land made by Boysel, second by Meyer. Motion granted.
- Mulch for the playground – Price organics suggested. Meyer to reach out to Tom
- Mark where park benches/dog waste sites need to go
- Meyer got quote for plaques (will add info for bench sponsorship to newsletter, will get to Boysel)
