REPORT FROM THE CHAIR - DAN BOYSEL

It has been a busy spring so far in Radnor Township. Your trustees have recently received a loan from First Citizens National Bank to construct a salt shed and equipment barn at the Radnor Road maintenance garage property. This will allow salt and road materials to be stored on location, bringing efficiencies to purchasing and time on the road acquiring materials. Construction begins this summer.

The board also has approved spending \$334,300 for township road improvements this summer. These improvements are purchased through Delaware County and will improve Gallant Road and Penry road. Centerline striping will take place on an additional 3 miles of roads. Additional road improvements will take place this summer on individual spot contracts.

Efforts have also been made to secure grant funding to assist in the upkeep of the park facilities, to keep it safe and inviting for the community.

The board and fire department is updating the 5 year strategic plan, as we look at growth in Delaware County's northwest townships.

RADNOR MEMORIAL DAY PARADE AND HOG ROAST

Once again, Radnor is set to host a Memorial Day parade and ceremony at the cemetery on Monday, May 30th; This year's featured speaker is Frank Hickman 11, who is a graduate of Buckeye Valley H.S., and went on to graduate from Middle Tennessee State University. After serving in

he U.S. Army in West Germany, and South Vietnam, Frank built a successful career in the private sector, and currently lives near Waldo on his family's old dairy farm.

In addition, the day's festivities include a fly over by Packer Aviation's bi-planes, a flag ceremony by Bellpoint's Boy Scout troop, and music by the Buckeye Valley Alumni Band. Randy Butts, the Radnor Fire Chief, has announced that the pulled pork lunch will be available via drive through at the firehouse, immediately following the parade. The Radnor Historical Museum will be open for visitation, as well.

The parade starts at 10:00 a.m. at Grace community Fellowship Church on Radnor Road, winding through the village, ending at the cemetery for the program. Should you wish to enter the parade, line up begins at 9:30 at the Church. We hope to see you there!

NEW FIRE/RESCUE TRUCK PUT INTO SERVICE



The Radnor Township Fire Department has recently put into service a 2022 Rosenbauer Fire/Rescue vehicle. The new engine is equipped with a 1,750 gallon per minute pump, hydraulic rescue tools, 4 person cab, miscellaneous fire / rescue tools, light tower, and green electric generator. The truck is designed to respond on auto accidents, miscellaneous service runs, and fire runs (as second engine). The Rosenbauer replaced our 1999 FireMaster Engine/Rescue.
